Draw a line to match each object to the type of weather that matches it.

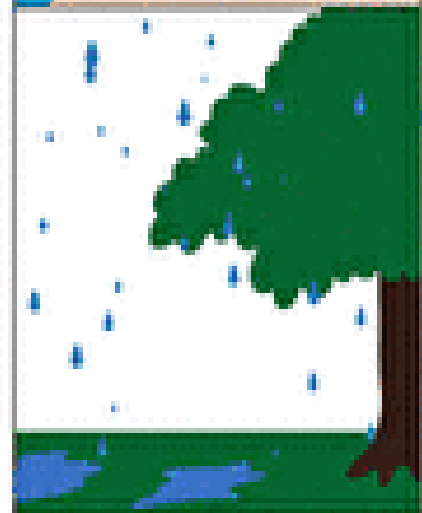
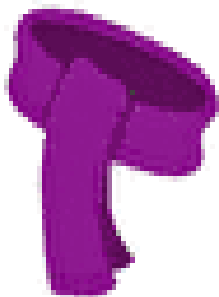
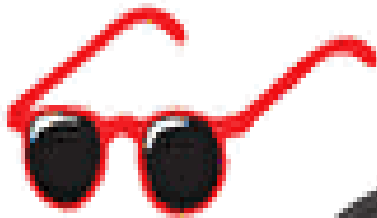
The matching exercise consists of three weather conditions in the center, each with a corresponding clothing item to its left and right. A line is drawn from the sun to the winter hat.

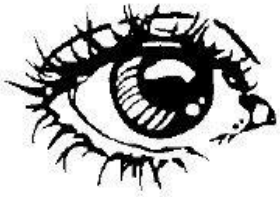
What Should I Wear?
